#### SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT - DECEMBER 8, 2024

This weekend (December 7th/8th), the Church celebrates the **Second Sunday of Advent**. Given how near **Christmastide** is, the Church now begins to turn her attention from the Second Coming of Christ at the end of time itself to His first coming in time at the Nativity. This shift is seen in our Gospel today through the words of St. John the Baptist, the forerunner and herald of the Christ. His words bore witness to the Redeemer's coming.

With the start of the new liturgical year last weekend, we also began a new year in our three-year lectionary cycle. Having entered into Year C of the cycle, we are now walking through the life of our Lord according to the Gospel of St. Luke. This Gospel is itself divided into four main sections: The Infancy Narratives (Luke 1-2), the Early Ministry (Luke 3-9), the Travel Narrative (Luke 10-19), and Holy Week (Luke 20-24).

Briefly breaking these four sections apart, we see that, in Luke's account of Jesus' life, we will walk through: (1) His birth in Bethlehem and upbringing in Nazareth (Luke 1-2); (2) Nearly one-year of His ministry in Galilee (Luke 3-9); (3) The momentous "death march" to Jerusalem in the final year of His life (Luke 10-19); and (4) The dramatic events of His Passion by which He ushered in the New Covenant (Luke 20-24; see especially 22:20).

This Gospel is the first of a two-volume work, continued in the Acts of the Apostles. St. Luke first shows how God's promises to Israel are fulfilled in Jesus and how the salvation promised to Israel and has been accomplished by Jesus and extended to the Gentiles. Continuing in Acts, there is the assurance that the historical ministry of Jesus is continued in the ministry of the apostles and this ensures the fidelity of the Church's teaching to the teaching of Jesus.

#### SOLEMNITY OF THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION - HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION

On Monday, December 9<sup>th</sup>, the Church celebrates the **Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception**, which is a **Holy Day of Obligation**. Though this celebration normally falls on December 8<sup>th</sup>, it was transferred this year as its original date falls on the **Second Sunday of Advent**. Given that our nation has been entrusted to the Blessed Mother under this title, this is our nation's patronal feast day and, as such, one we desire to celebrate yearly.

To help provide for our obligation to assist at Mass on this day, we will offer Masses for the Holy Day of Obligation on Monday, December 9<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 AM, Noon, and 7:00 PM.

Additional Holy Day Mass Times at surrounding parishes: St. Aloysius in Yoder: Sunday, Dec.  $8^{th}$  at 6:30 PM and Monday, Dec.  $9^{th}$  at 9:00 AM and 6:30 PM; St. Mary's in Decatur: Sunday, Dec.  $8^{th}$  at 6:00 PM and Monday, Dec.  $9^{th}$  at 8:10 AM, Noon, and 6:00 PM.

This coming Wednesday, December 11<sup>th</sup>, we will have our annual Advent Penance Service from 6:00 - 7:00 PM in the Church. We will be joined by four priests to help with hearing confessions. I would encourage you to join us, especially if it may have been some time since you've last had a chance to avail yourself of this wondrous Sacrament. What better way to prepare our hearts for Christmas Day than to give it over to the Lord in Confession.
