#### FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT - MARCH 9, 2025

This weekend (March 8<sup>th</sup>/9<sup>th</sup>), the Church celebrates the **First Sunday of Lent**. And so begins our *Lenten journey*. The celebration of **Lent** itself dates back to at least the *Council of Nicaea* in AD 325, though the practice of fasting in preparation for Easter finds its roots in the Apostolic Age. This was initially asked only of those desiring to enter into the Church each year, but, over time, this period of preparation for **Easter Sunday** was adopted for the benefit and at the request of the Faithful.

#### THE SEVEN LAST WORDS - STARTING TUESDAY AT 6 PM

First popularized in the 17th Century, **Lent** would rarely pass by without parishes offering a special devotion to "*The Seven Last Words*." This devotion reflects upon the seven final words, or sayings, of Jesus from upon the Cross as recorded in the Sacred Scriptures. These seven sayings focus on themes of: Forgiveness, Salvation, Relationship, Abandonment, Distress, Triumph, and Reunion. In them, we are able to join our Lord at the foot of the Cross.

We will be reviving this devotion on Tuesdays over the next several weeks of **Lent** in the Parish Conference Room. Joining with Dr. Scott Hahn from the St. Paul Center and the Floriani Music Society, we will weekly engage with a beautifully produced reflection into the love our Savior as revealed on the Cross. After the reflection, we will have a time for discussion and prayer.

Our first evening of reflection is this **Tuesday**, **Mar.** 11<sup>th</sup> from 6-7:00 PM in the Parish Conference Room. We will focus on the first of the seven last words: "Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do" (Luke 23:34).

#### THE LIGHT IS ON FOR YOU

This week, our parish will join parishes throughout our diocese for the annual "The Light Is On For You" Campaign. On Tuesday, March 11<sup>th</sup>, every parish in our diocese will be offering Confessions from 6:00-8:00 PM. A special "Thank you!" to Fr. Bill Sullivan who will be hearing confessions for us during this time. (Reminder: Our weekly Confession times are Tues. from 8:30-9:00 AM, Wed. 6-6:45 PM, and Sat. 8:30-9:00 AM and 4-4:45 PM.)

#### PRAISE AND WORSHIP HOLY HOUR

This Wednesday (March 12<sup>th</sup>), our normal 6:00-7:00 PM Holy Hour will be a special Praise and Worship Holy Hour led by our Youth Group. Following the great experience that many of our youth had at **Camp Damascus** this past summer, several have volunteered to help lead music for a monthly holy hour. A special "*Thank You!*" to Nick, our Engagement Director, for helping to organize this effort on behalf of our youth.

#### MASS SETTINGS - MASS OF OUR LADY

As part of our parish's preparation for **Easter**, we will be learning a new Mass Setting throughout **Lent** for use in the **Easter Season**. A Mass Setting are the sung parts of the Mass, often sung using the same tune so as to express the unity of the whole liturgy from beginning to end. To introduce this new setting, we will "sing through" a different part before Mass each weekend during **Lent**. By **Easter Sunday**, we will have sung the entire setting.

This new Mass Setting is called "The Mass of Our Lady." It was written by Steve Warner and Karen Schneider-Kirner, whom composed the setting together in 2012 while co-leading the *Notre Dame Folk Choir* in South Bend. Given this connection to Notre Dame, the setting is already widely used in parishes throughout the South Bend-side of our diocese and has continued to spread to parishes in the Fort Wayne-side over the years.

This has been a setting that I had hoped we'd introduce to our parish for some time, both due to its familiarity in parishes throughout our diocese and its beautiful simplicity. The tune itself is very joyous and uplifting and, musically, very accessible to all (*myself included!*). Sadly, due to differing publishing houses, this setting is not in our hymnals. As such, we'll include a printed insert with the Mass Setting within our hymnals come **Easter**.




