



Summer Reading Program

June 5-August 7, 2022
Saint Joseph Catholic Church

How it works:

1. Read religious books and log them on the attached paper! You can borrow books from the St. Joseph Children's bookcart or read your own books at home. This program is particularly for religious education, so any books logged should be religious in nature. Reading your Bible also counts!!!
2. Prizes are given according to the amount and level of books read. Elementary students receive a prize for every 3 picture books read, or for 1 chapter book. Middle and high school students receive a prize for every 2 chapter books read, or for 5 picture books. If reading your Bible, one Bible story is equivalent to one picture book. One book of the Bible is equivalent to one chapter book.
3. Books checked out from the bookcart in the narthex are limited to 2 books at a time per reader. These books must be returned before borrowing new books. When borrowing a book, remove the library card from the book, write your name on it, and place it in the library card box (suggestion card box). To return, place in the "Return" box below the table. Our volunteers will check the book back in and reshelve. Please handle books with care!
4. Collect prizes after Mass! Please bring your list to volunteer at our summer reading program table.
5. Open to ages 2-18.
6. Grand prize given to the reader who logs the most pages!
